Minutes- Steve J moved, and Kate seconded, to accept the June minutes. Motion passed.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

PUBLIC AFFAIRS- Dave said that he, Fairfield Utilities, and Jamie from Strand reviewed all the repairs necessary at the lagoons. Fairfield Utilities also has a scope that we can use to check the issue at Connie Butterbaugh's house. They are working on the mowing at the lagoons He said that the name badges, Village T shirts, and truck signs are ordered. The back driveway at the Municipal Building is finished. Don Frank, in West Rushville, wants to put in water. He said he wants to be able to switch to Village water if the pump goes down. Cindy said that he either goes on our water or he doesn't. Jennifer said that the EPA is adamant about that. We can't allow his well water to mix with our water system. Dave said that John had asked if Gary Hoskins was coming back, and Dave said by August 2.

FINANCE- Steve L presented the Preliminary Budget. He would like to have a Finance Committee meeting before the next Council meeting. He presented Ordinance 8-2024-An Ordinance Adopting and Approving the Village of Rushville 2025 Preliminary Budget and the 2025 Budget Requirements of the Fairfield County Auditor.
