AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE VILLAGE CLERK TO POST NOTICES and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, Ohio Revised Code §731.25 requires summaries of ordinances and resolutions, and publication of all statements, orders, proclamations, notices, and reports, required by law or ordinance to be published, shall be accomplished by posting copies in not less than five of the most public places in the village, as determined by the legislative authority, for a period of not less than fifteen days prior to the effective date thereof.

Whereas, Ohio Revised Code §731.25 further provides notices to bidders for the construction of public improvements and notices of the sale of bonds shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in such municipal corporation, for the time prescribed in Ohio Revised Code §731.22.

Whereas, Ohio Revised Code §731.24 provides that, immediately after the expiration of the period of publication of summaries of ordinances required by section 731.22 of the Revised Code, the clerk of the legislative authority of a municipal corporation shall enter on the record of ordinances, in a blank to be left for such purpose under the recorded ordinance, a certificate stating in which newspaper and on what dates such publication was made, and shall sign the clerk's name thereto officially;

Whereas, the best five locations to post notices required by Ohio law include the Marathon service station, the village municipal building, the village hall, the blessing box, and the US post office; and

Whereas, the public would further be served by posting notices required by Ohio law on social media, including the village website and the village Facebook page.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RUSHVILLE, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council directs the village clerk to post official notices required by Ohio law at Marathon service station, the village municipal building, the village hall, the blessing box, and the US post office.

Section 2. Council directs the village clerk to post notices to bidders for the construction of public improvements in the Lancaster Eagle Gazette newspaper, and additionally on such other social media or public forums as will best provide notice to the public.

Section 3. Council directs the village clerk to certify, in accord with Ohio Revised Code §731.24, that notice was properly published or posted, or both.
